PLACES TO VISIT

Ajanta Caves



The Ajanta Caves are 30 rock-cut Buddhist cave monuments dating from the second century BCE to about 480 CE in Chh. Sambhajinagar district of Maharashtra state in India. Ajanta Caves are a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Universally regarded as masterpieces of Buddhist religious art, the caves include paintings and rock-cut sculptures, described as among the finest surviving examples of ancient Indian art, particularly expressive paintings that present emotions through gesture, pose and form.

Ellora Caves

The Ellora Caves are a UNESCO World Heritage Site in Chh. Sambhajinagar, India. It is one of the largest rock-cut cave complexes in the world, with artwork dating from AD 600–1000, including Hindu, Buddhist, and Jain caves. The complex is a leading example of Indian rock-cut architecture, and several are not strictly "caves" in that they have no roof. Cave 16 features the largest single monolithic rock excavation in the world, the Kailash temple, a chariot-shaped monument dedicated to the god Shiva. The Kailash temple excavation also features sculptures depicting various Hindu deities as well as relief panels summarizing the two major Hindu epics.



Bibi-Ka-Maqbara




The Bibi Ka Maqbara is a tomb located in the city of Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar, formerly Aurangabad in the Indian state of Maharashtra. It was commissioned in 1660 by the Mughal emperor Aurangzeb's son, Prince Azam Shah, in the memory of his mother Dilras Banu Begum (posthumously known as Rabi-ul-Durrani). It bears a striking resemblance to the Taj Mahal, the mausoleum of Aurangzeb's mother, Mumtaz Mahal, which is why it is also called the Taj of the Deccan or the Dakkhani Taj. Bibi Ka Maqbara is the second largest structure built by Aurangzeb, the largest being the Badshahi Mosque.

Ghrishneshwar Temple

Ghrishneshwar Jyotirlinga is a Hindu temple of Shiva in Verul village of Chh. Sambhajinagar district, Maharashtra, India. It is one of the 12 Jyotirlinga mandirs. The mandir is a national protected site, one and a half kilometers away from the Ellora Caves, 30 kilometres (19 miles) north-west of the city Chh. Sambhajinagar and 300 kilometres (190 miles) east-northeast far from Mumbai. Ghrishneshwar is mentioned in the Shiva Purana, the Skanda Purana, the Ramayana and the Mahabharata.



Daulatabad Fort



Constructed back in the 12th century, the robust Daulatabad Fort is considered to be a very powerful fortification of the medieval era. Perched atop a conical hill at an elevation of 200 meters from sea level, this fort posed to be a real challenge to defeat. This fort had multiple layers of strong defence walls and could only be accessed by a slender bridge.

Dedicated to the Hindu god Lord Hanuman, Bhadra Maruti is one of the three temples of the country where the god can be seen in sleeping position. According to popular beliefs the ruler of Khultabad was called Bhadravati and the king was devoted to Lord Rama.

Shirdi, located in Maharashtra, is a famous pilgrimage town known as the home of Saint Sai Baba. Devotees from across India and the world visit Shirdi Sai Baba Temple to seek blessings and experience spiritual peace.
